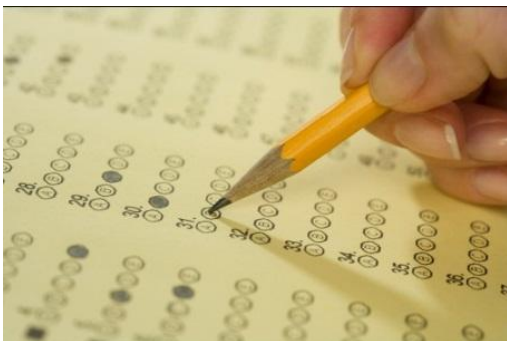
Therefore...Please do not allow cellphones in the class during any final exam. Any cell phones brought into the exam room must be placed on the front table.

SHS EXAMINATION ROOM PROTOCOL

- ✓ All examinations begin at 9:00 am unless stated otherwise in the schedule. (Arrive early to ensure you can get logged onto laptops, if using!)
- ✓ The ONLY materials on a student's desk/table will be the examination materials and writing implements. Please have additional writing implements with you for use. Staplers and extra paper are often required as well and will be provided in the examination room.
- ✓ The government examination/ teacher's examination will specify if a calculator/ dictionary/ thesaurus/ periodic table/ other materials are permitted.
- ✓ Cell phones, electronic dictionaries, or other technological devices are **NOT permitted in the examination room**. This includes MP3 players as music is NOT permitted during a final examination. All devices should be left in the students' lockers. **Students who do not comply with this rule will receive a grade of zero on their final examinations; an additional/makeup examination will **NOT** be given.**
- ✓ Only water bottles (CAPPED container) are permitted in the examination room. Food is NOT permitted.
- ✓ Students must be escorted to and from the bathroom.
- ✓ Students **MUST REMAIN** in the examination room for 1 hour. If students refuse to utilize their time effectively, they can put their heads down on their desks. (They will not be permitted to read, play music, make airplanes, etc.)
- ✓ **Failure to comply with the examination rules will result in removal from the room and/or a grade of zero.**
