Complete an entire program (Health Care Aide)





What happens in Kindergarten?

Before you register

Make sure you know which is your Designated School.

You will need also need:

- Proof of age such as a child's birth certificate or immigration documentation (for newcomers)
- Legal land description or rural address (Rural Students only)
- Copies of any court orders affecting the student

How to register

If you are new to Pembina Hills and have no other children attending one of our schools, you will need to create a new parent account in SchoolEngage.

If you have children attending our schools, you can access SchoolEngage through your **PowerSchool Parent Portal** .

- Click on Registration and Demographic Updates
- If you do not have a PowerSchool Parent account setup, you can do so by following the instructions on the PowerSchool for parents page under the section **Creating your Account**.
- You will need your child's access ID information from your school office.

> Existing families – Login to your PowerSchool Parent Portal

Once you are logged in to SchoolEngage:

- Click Add Student > enter the First Name, Last Name and Birth Date
- Select Student Name from list and Click 22-23 New Student Registration Form (K-12)

Do you need busing?

If you need to apply or register for busing, you will receive an email with busing information after your registration form is approved.
